Economically Disadvantaged Women– Owned Small Business Certification Eligibility Requirements

- At least 51% ownership must be unconditional and direct by a woman or a group of women
- Applicant must be U.S. citizens
- Business must utilize one or more of the NAICS codes designated as eligible for federal contracting under the WOSB Program. (check the eligibility spreadsheet)
- Business must be considered small in accordance with NAICS size standards. (check the NAICS size standards chart)
- Business must have customers/clients
- Applicant must have ultimate managerial and supervisory control over the business
- Applicant must manage, control, and operate daily business
- Applicant must hold the highest officer position(s), manage it on a full-time basis, have no outside employment
- Business must be legally organized and in good standing as required by all applicable federal, state, county, or city regulations in which the applicant operates
- Applicant must have personal net worth of less than \$750,000 (excludes ownership in business and primary personal residence, IRA accounts, income reinvested or used to pay taxes of business)
- Applicant women's adjusted gross yearly income averaged over 3 years preceding certification must not exceed \$350,000 (excludes income reinvested or used to pay taxes of business)
- The fair market value of all of the applicant(s) assets (including primary residence and the value of the business concern, but excluding funds invested in IRA or other official retirement account) must not exceed \$6 million
- Business cannot be owned by an irrevocable trust. The trust must be revocable, where the woman is the grantor, the trustee, and the sole current beneficiary of the trust

- The federal government must award 5% (roughly \$25 billion) of its prime and subcontract dollars to certified woman businesses.
- Business certified as EDWOSB qualify for extra funding and may be selected in a smaller set-aside solicitation pool than businesses certified as WOSB
