Woman-Owned Small Business Certification WOSB Eligibility Requirements

- At least 51% of business ownership must be unconditional and direct by a woman or group of women
- The applicant (woman or women) must be U.S. citizen(s)
- Business must utilize one or more of the NAICS codes designated as eligible for federal contracting under the WOSB Program – please provide a brief description of the products and/or services you provide (check the eligibility spreadsheet)
- Business must be considered small in accordance with NAICS size standards – please provide your average annual revenue (check the NAICS size standards chart)
- Business must have customers/clients
- Applicant must have ultimate managerial and supervisory control over the business
- Applicant must manage, control, and operate daily business
- Applicant must hold the highest officer position(s), manage it on a full-time basis, and have no outside employment
- Business must be legally organized and in good standing as required by all applicable federal, state, county, or city regulations in which the applicant operates
- Business cannot be owned by an irrevocable trust. The trust must be revocable, where the woman is the grantor, the trustee, and the sole current beneficiary of the trust

- Business certified as WOSB qualifies for extra funding, and may be selected in a smaller set-aside solicitation pool than other businesses
